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# Red Carpet Hair Looks

Metallic gowns and understated makeup were the look of the night, while simplicity in hairstyles reigned in two forms: the updo and hair worn down. Now that you've admired them, it's time to steal these looks and bring some glam to everyday life.

Sandra Bullock not only won Best Actress, she won Best Hair in my book, with her chic, side-parted style. Molly Ringwald and Kate Winslet followed suit with simple, understated elegance. From Sandra's deep chestnut to Molly's rich red to Kate's silken blonde, knockout color was the basis for Oscar night hair.

What's my approach to sleek, red carpet hair? Redken's Cover Fusion to hide grays and give the perfect balance of coverage and depth.

To get Bullock's super shiny tresses, work Redken Outshine 01 Pol-

ishing Milk into damp hair for maximum shine and sleekness, and blow dry with a round brush for volume. Then, create a dramatic side part starting mid-eyebrow. Follow with a straightener to create maximum shine, twisting the flat iron at the ends of your hair to create curl. Yes, flat irons are fantastic for creating simple curls. (For those of you with bangs, a la Molly Ringwald, use a simple center part.) Finish with a firm-hold spray to keep your hair flawless for the duration.

This year's red carpet parade also showed that the romantic updo is perfect for all ages. From titans like Meryl Streep, to emerging starlets like Zoe Saldana, the updo was a must-have for the red carpet. To achieve your own look, start with a lightweight mousse on damp hair and blow dry with your head upside down to create volume. Pull the sides of the hair back into a ponytail, leaving the crown of the hair free. Take the ponytail almost all the way through, creating a bun at the back of the head, and secure with bobby pins. Backcomb the hair at the crown of your head and secure that with bobby pins as well. Finally, tousle the hair at the end to give it a relaxed, fashionably disheveled look.
